

A Premier Drakensberg Hotel nestled below the third highest peak in South Africa, Champagne Castle (3377m), part of the main escarpment within the uKhahlamba-Drakensberg mountain range. Due to its diversity of plant, bird and insect life and the richest collection of San rock paintings in Africa, it has been declared a Mixed World Heritage Site.

FACILITIES & ACTIVITIES

- Restaurants & Bars: The Restaurant is beautifully appointed and faces the mountain and the hotel verandah, max 140 people (breakfast, lunch & dinner) served buffet style offering an extensive menu. In consideration of our other guests, we regret no children under 8 years after 8pm. Dress Code after 6pm is strictly Smart Casual (no shorts). The Bar is a wonderful combination of comfort, ambience (open fireplace), mountain outlook & patio access, and is open till late. The Patio overlooking the pool area with wonderful views of the surrounding mountains. It is an extension of our restaurant, lounge and bar areas. A patio menu is available from 10am to 5pm daily except Sundays between 12pm & 2.30pm, while we serve an extensive Sunday lunch in our restaurant).
